## Overall Situation

North Korea regime has increased hostilities via the usual DMZ violations deemed “navigation errors” made by their fighter pilots.

As a precaution measure, the command had decided to deploy 8 F-16 Fighters to Kimpo airbase.

The 87<sup>th</sup> Squadron was tasked to ferry the airframes from Fukuoka Airbase to Kimpo Airbase, following RNAV airways routes for deconfliction purposes.

At this stage, Airspace remains open to civilian traffic, should the situation change, you will receive an inflight update and revert to combat ready procedures.

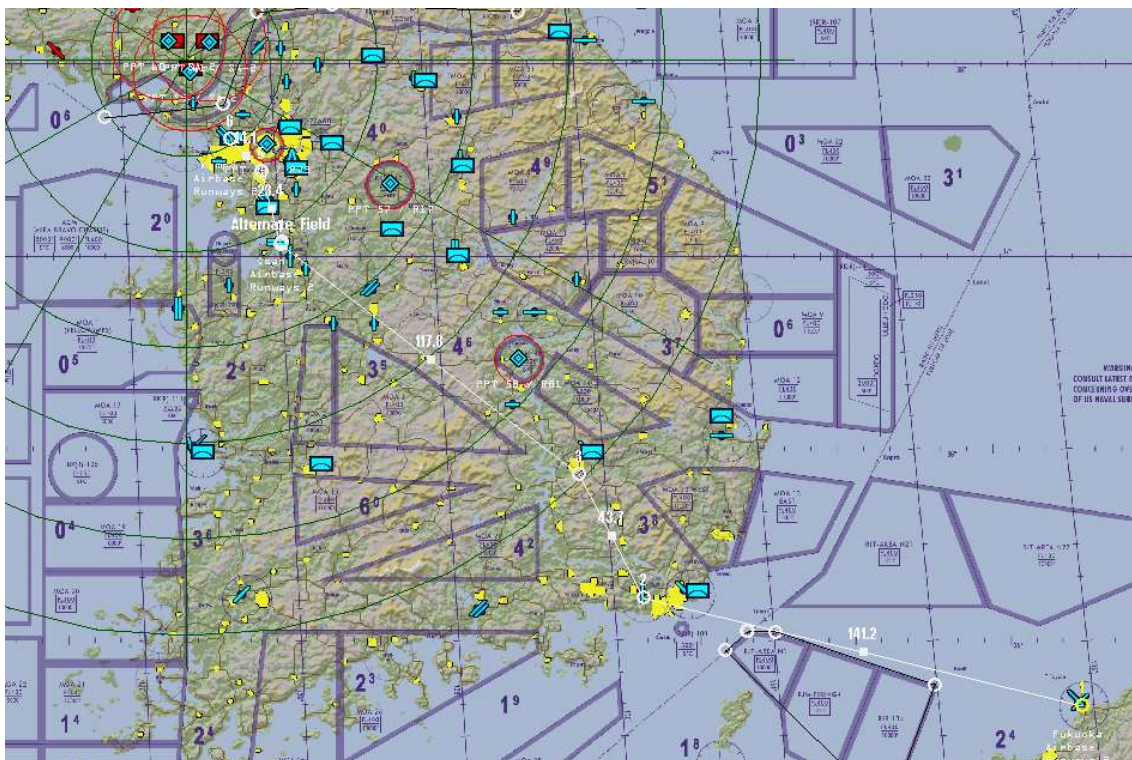

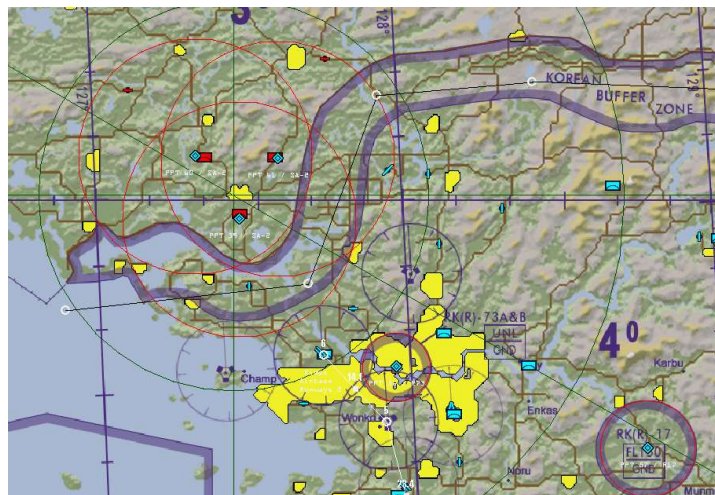
## Enemy Threat/ INTEL

### Air-to-Air Threats:

- Enemy CAP aircraft are likely to be operating in close proximity to DMZ area.
- All Flights will carry a combat ready loadout.

### Surface-To-Air threats:

- SA2 Sites north of Kimpo Airbase. Overhead recovery in force.



## ROE

1. Jackal6 is Mission Commander;
2. Flight path is unchangeable
3. A-A loadout is changeable
4. Do not engage any Aircraft unless threatened and South Korean airspace is closed to civilian traffic.

## Code Words

- Mission Abort – ShutDown
- Flight Abort – EagleShot
- Element Abort – BrokenWing
- Civilian Airspace closed – Party Over
- DMZ Violation - ShowTime
